Notification

- ① Be prepared for first aid kit and emergency tools.
- ② Inquire your customers for illness (heart diseases, hypertension, etc....), pregnancy, or alcohol intake.
- ③ Remind customers to stay calm for assistance when falling into the water. Inform your instructors when feeling uncomfortable.
- ④ Make sure all the safety devices (helmet, life jacket) are well equipped.
- ⑤ The instructor should periodically check on customers during the activity and provide proper assistance when needed.

Pre-Activity

Participants

- Select qualified service providers (registration or insurance documents)
※ Official on-line website and QR code scanning are also available.
- Follow the introduction and notification from instructors.
- Be aware of the area and environment of the activity .
- Maintain healthy physical condition.
- Ensure the instruments/gears are functional.
- Qualified instructors are required.



Service Providers

- To know the local weather conditions. (wind, current, and tidal change)
- Introduction to the equipment, demonstration of the activity and safety education.
- Ensure the motor vessels are well functional.
- Communication devices and first aid kit.
- Verify the physical condition and age limitation of participants.



During-Activity


Participants

- To follow the instruction and prevent from dangerous acts.
- Be aware of the ropes and connecting devices when getting on and off the tubs/sleds.
- Ensure your equipment is in position and well functional.
- Preventing from rope tangling with your arms and legs.
- Feet above the water surface for all time.
- To inform your instructor(s) when feeling ill.
- Stay calm, floating with lifejackets, and waiting for rescue when accidentally going overboard.



Service Providers

- Keep safety distance between the towed tube/sled and other people in the water.
- Be aware of the safe carrying capacity.
- No speeding.
- Check safety of the towrope, towrope loop, and connector to prevent from accidents.
- Be aware of the physical condition of the riders.



Post-Activity

Participants

- Getting off the tube/sled when not in motion and follow the instruction of instructor(s).
- Return all instruments and gears.
- Do not leave your personal belongings and trash behind.



Service Providers

- Counting heads and gears.
- Rinsing all gears
- Check powerboat、towline、inflatable tube/sled for scratch and leaking.
